

Good Life Camp



What is the “Good Life”? The Ojibwe phrase for this is mino-bimaadiziwin, which describes a philosophy of positive, balanced, behaviors, and thinking that are integral to our culture’s identity. We established the Good Life Vision to teach tribal youth about Ojibwe history, values, and practices to support parenting and reduce the negative effects of generations of cultural trauma.

The Good Life Camp launched in 2022 held at Camp Highlands in Sayner, WI. The camp children aged 11-13 from our tribal community to learn the foundation for responsible parenting through culture and history. Campers developed Ojibwe language skills, practice protocols for song and dance, and deepened their understanding of traditional uses of natural resources. Campers were also able to swim, learn archery, and make traditional crafts. All very important parenting skills for our tribal youth.

2023 Good Life Camp will have 50+ tribal youth.
